This checklist will be used to evaluate the following types of development applications:

- Major and Minor Development Permits
- Development Variance Permits
- Amendments to the Land Use Regulation Bylaw and OCP
- Preliminary Layout Approval of Subdivision

All of the above-noted applications will require a completed Sustainability Checklist with their development proposal. This will enable staff to track the implementation of sustainable developments within the City of Nelson.

ABOUT THE CHECKLIST

The checklist is broken down into four sections representing the four pillars of sustainability: environmental, social, economic and cultural indicators. Applicants will be awarded 1 point for each 'yes' answer and 0 points for each 'no' answer. If any answers are not applicable to your proposal, please indicate n/a in the checklist and explain why the item does not apply to your proposal. Developers should return a completed copy of the checklist when submitting their development application: This will enable Staff to track the implementation of sustainable features within the City of Nelson.
